Among the changes this year:

The **college rooms** will be at MORRIS HALL, a different place than previously used. For those of you needing dorm rooms for the event, get a copy of the room reservations form via the internet at spiritofvincennes.org . Click on Vincennes Rendezvous, then click on Participant Information in the sidebar. Click on Vincennes University Dorm REGISTRATION FORM at the bottom of the page. Rooms are \$18 per person plus \$5 for linens. **Don't wait too long since the registration is by mail.**

Rivet High School will NOT be selling breakfast at their gym this year. However, the Park Volunteers WILL still have free coffee (and *maybe* doughnuts) at the registration area next to the GRCNHP Visitor Center.

There will be an 18th C. **Public Ball** at the nearby Historic States Buildings/Grouseland site Saturday Night. Fancy dress welcome; participants are urged to dress accordingly, but costumes for the townsfolk are optional. Refreshments to be served.

We will have a complete evening meal served to us from the wooded area (henceforth to be known as "Bailey's Advance" in honor of GRC's troops under Bailey that attacked Fort Sackville from about this site in 1779) south of the Visitor Center. The actual serving will be from a new Marquee tent, but you will still take the food back to camp (or wherever you want) to eat--no huge dining tent like at the Grand Encampment (hey--that thing cost *eight grand* to rent!). The caterer is the same one as from the Grand Encampment. Dinner tickets will be provided when you register at the Visitor Center Volunteer camp (along with all the other handout info).

The Park and the Rendezvous grounds suffered storm damage recently, but the downed trees should be completely gone by the time we get there.

If you are motel-ing it, watch for road construction on the Rt 41 bi-pass between Hart and Willow streets. This should not be a factor for most of you coming from the north.

If anyone is interested, they will be having a Civil War event at the Rendezvous grounds in September
