- *Belts*
- *Neck stocks (include method of closing)*
- *Breeches/Trousers/Petticoats (includes all other lower body garments, including kilts)*
- *Stockings/Garters/Gaiters/Leggings/Spatterdashes.*
- *Footwear (includes shoes, boots, moccasins, pattens, etc.)*
- *Overcoats/Capotes/Cloaks/Capes/Shawls*
- *Items of Personal Adornment (include rank distinctions, eye glasses, jewelry, and pocket watches)*

Unless otherwise documented, women need at least one item from each of the following categories: headgear, shifts/chemise, petticoat, stockings, footwear, and a jacket or gowns.

Unless otherwise documented, non-uniformed males need at least one item from each of the following categories: headgear, shirt, waistcoat, coat, breeches, stockings, and footwear.

In most cases, children require the same items as their adult counterparts with the exception of coats for boys. Infants should have at least headgear and shirt/shift.
